

GREEN LIGHT EDUCATION ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

CAPD started a new program in Colombia called the **Green Light Education Assistance Program**. This program selects children associated with our community partners and from schools in Bucaramanga & Piedecuesta as well as children from a rural area called the Mesa de los Santos in Santander, Colombia. Children from low-income families, single parent homes, and who have disability in the family are given priority.

The program requires the children to attend school on a regular basis and to achieve an average of 75% or above to continue. In 2010, 195 children were able to access in a lunch program and 81 children received school and sport uniforms, shoes and school supplies as a result of the Green Light program.



In the Mesa de los Santos, the program helps 195 children who were going to school without lunch, to access a lunch program in the school restaurant. Now they are happier and can study harder, or at least that is the idea!



Children from other areas received school uniforms (left), sport uniforms (right), shoes and school supplies. Equal numbers of boys and girls received the benefit, despite the predominance of girls in these pictures.
